2.1 Role country leaders

1. Is a responsible, mature Person and at least 21 years old.
2. Daily meetings with the YC and TL and also in the end for summary. Important to be on every meeting.
3. Make sure your horses are vaccinated by the international rules. This is CL responsibility.
4. Responsible for horses and having the stables tidy.
5. Have to sleep with the participants of the country.
6. Is responsible for the sleeping hours (horses and people).



6. Participate in flag rising in the morning and evening
7. Is in charge of the lodging of the participants and that the rules there are followed, quiet time after 23.00-23.30 hours.
8. CL responsible for riding on Wednesday. Light training is only allowed, lunging, walking or country side riding.
9. Is the 'mother' of the team! And makes sure that the team is doing well.



3.1 Role of the head country leader

1. Prepares the daily country leaders meetings with all the information for the CL's.
2. Answers to all questions arising from the CL's.
1. Gives out notebooks and the guidelines.
1. Makes a time and day schedule for the flag raising.
2. Makes a schedule for who's to sleep with the participants of the CL's.
3. Responsible for the CL's so that they have the stables tidy.
4. Appointed FEIF Stable "checker" – makes also sure there is a tick of schedule at each horse's box.



3.2 Role of the head country leader

7. Contact with the host country's stable manager.
8. Participates in the CL meeting and also the TL meetings (to get firsthand information from the TL's).
9. Is responsible for the sleeping hours (horses and people) and time table for feeding the horses.
10. Is in charge of the lodging of the participants and that the rules there are followed, quiet time after 23.00-23.30 hours.
